and **partnering** with stakeholders to promote school - community partnerships & provide support to programme.



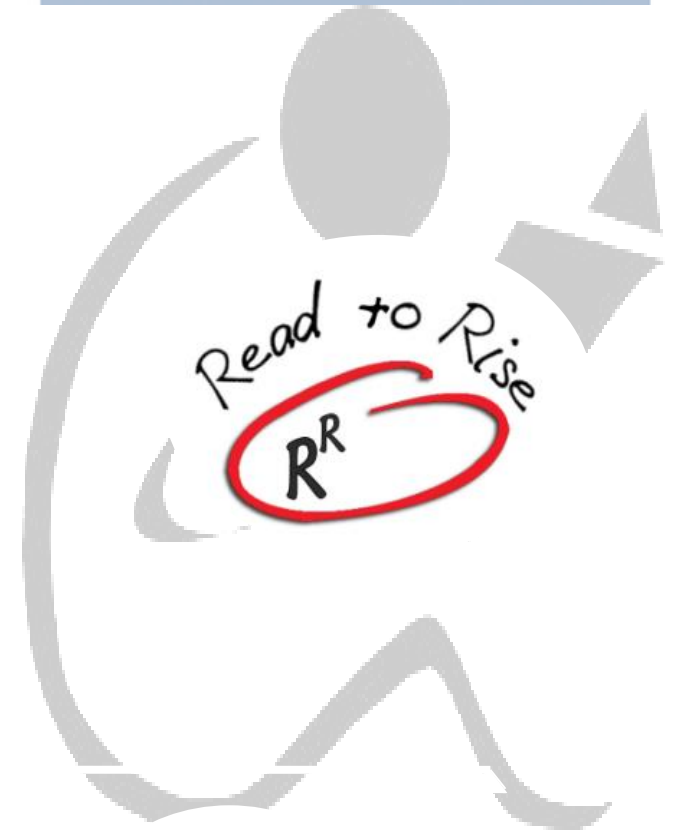

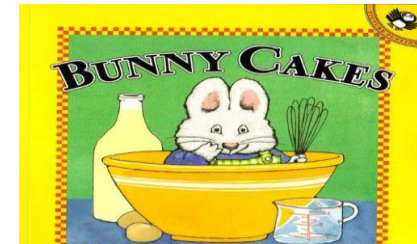

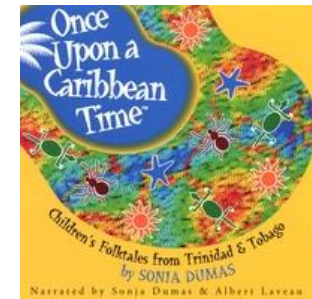
